

We promote a forest management respectful of the environment, socially useful and economically sustainable

The Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) is an international organization not governmental, independent and non-profit, established in 1993 to promote the responsible management of forests and plantations.

It includes among its members NGOs and environmental groups (WWF, Greenpeace), social (National Aboriginal Forestry Association of Canada), forest owners, and trading industries wood and paper work (Tetra Pak, Mondi), organized retail groups, researchers and technicians, for a total of more than 1000 members.

The FSC brand identifies products containing wood from forests managed in a responsible way, according to strict environmental, social and economic standards: the forest of origin is controlled and evaluated independently according to international principles and criteria established and approved by the Forest Stewardship Council through the participation and consent of all stakeholders.











Forests are part of our daily lives in many ways: from books to shopping bags, from chairs to doors and even the air we breathe and the water we drink, we rely very much on trees. This is why it is important to verify that the products we use are forest friendly. The FSC trademarks on the products appear in the form of so-called labels (certification labels): only certified companies can use these labels on certified products, to guarantee that the product you are buying is made of wood or paper from responsible sources.

What is their meaning?

There are three types of FSC on-product labels



FSC 100%

The FSC 100% label means that the wood within the product comes completely from FSC-certified well-managed forests.



FSC Recycled

The FSC Recycled label means all the wood or paper in the product comes from reclaimed (re-used) material.



FSC Mix

The FSC Mix label means the wood within the product is from FSC-certified forests, recycled material, or controlled wood (with at least 70% of FSC-certified and/or recycled material).


FSC Italia and TABU s.p.a.

Born in 1927 in Cantù, TABU s.p.a is an Italian excellence in wood dyeing: in over 90 of experience, TABU has developed advanced technologies, combining market needs, innovation and sustainability. In 2003 TABU achieved certification of its Chain of Custody according to the standards of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC-C007771), later adding the Ecozero certification, which guarantees the absence of formaldehyde in the glues used in the production of multilaminar wood veneers.

Following this path, in 2018 TABU launched the IDEASxWOOD contest, under the patronage of FSC Italia, FederlegnoArredo and ADI, in collaboration with IQD Magazine: addressing students and Under 40 professionals, with the aim to stimulate knowledge of wood through









accessories, made with the use of TABU surfaces and FSC certified wood.


Special mention by FSC Italy

In addition to the prizes guaranteed by the competition, there will be a special FSC mention for projects involving a greater presence of FSC certified material (compared to the total volume of the prototype) and / or particular attention to the FSC proven provenance of the used tree species. Therefore, the attention of the designer must focus on using, fully or partly, the wood veneers of the Tabu Collection 555.18 (see box below), indicating in the project file the commercial name, the tree species and the type of FSC certification (100% or mixed).
